#### IE Admissions Scholarship for Outstanding International Students (2023-24 Entry)

#### CUHK and Department of Information Engineering (IE)

Founded in 1963, The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) is a forward-looking comprehensive research university with a global vision. A renowned institute, **CUHK is generally recognized as a Top-50 university in the world** – ranked 39th by QS World University Rankings and 49th by Times Higher Education World University Rankings in 2022.

The Department of Information Engineering (IE) was established in 1989, under the leadership of future Nobel laureate, Prof. Charles Kao. A core mission of IE is to nurture engineering leaders for Hong Kong and the world, and the primary medium of instruction at CUHK IE is English. Since its establishment, IE is home to numerous distinguished scholars and educators who have expertise in different topics of Electronic Engineering and Computer Science. Many IE alumni went on to become successful engineers and researchers in Asia, UK, and North America.

#### IE Admissions Scholarship

- Objective:  
To recognize students with excellent academic performance who are keen to study IE's **Bachelor of Engineering in Information Engineering (IERG)** or **Bachelor of Science in Mathematics and Information Engineering (MIEG)** at The Chinese University of Hong Kong
- Award Amount:  
Up to HK\$195,000 per annum (i.e. HK\$780,000 for 4 years of normative study period) covering tuition fee, on-campus student housing and basic living expenses
- Scholarship Renewal:  
Subject to academic performance at grade point average of 3.00 or above (out of 4.00) each year

#### The Nominated Students

- Nomination Quota: Three (3) high school final year students with outstanding academic performance nominated by high school principals
- Target Students:
  1. Outstanding results in GSAT (學測) or AST (指考) (competitive score for reference: overall score of all GSAT/AST subjects taken to be above the sum of each subject's Top Percentile (頂標) scores); OR in
    - i. GCE with A\* in at least 3 AL subjects (excluding Chinese); or
    - ii. IB Diploma with 40 points or above out of 45; or
    - iii. SAT with an overall total score of 1430 or above out of 1600;

AND

2. IELTS (academic level) 6.0 or TOEFL (iBT) 80 or equivalent, or other English language qualification as stipulated by CUHK

AND

3. Students who are not residents of Hong Kong/Mainland China.

### Assessment Criteria

Nominated students will be considered for scholarships based on:

- Academic performance;
- Personal attributes;
- Extra-curricular activities;
- Devotion to studying Information Engineering / Mathematics and Information Engineering; and
- Interview performance

### Nomination and Application Procedures

- 1) Principal nominates a maximum of three (3) students by completing the attached “Nomination Form”.
- 2) Nominated students submit online application for admissions on CUHK website: <http://admission.cuhk.edu.hk/international/application-details.html>
- 3) Nominated students attend interview upon their submission of the online application via CUHK website.
- 4) Successful applicants receive results of admission and scholarship (if applicable).
