## 【Online Workshop only for Presenters】 **August 5th, Saturday, 13:00-15:00 JST**

- ① Elected presenters are **strongly recommended** to attend a seminar (before the symposium) to receive feedbacks on their draft slides from English speaking instructors and professors.
- ② To attend this seminar, presenters must submit their draft slides (pdf or ppt format) by **August 3rd**.

The draft slides must follow the template below:

1. Brief Self-Introduction
2. Original/Personal Question
3. Literature Review
4. Research Question
5. Method
6. Result
7. Discussion
8. What I learned from this research
